

# AGC NEBRASKA CHAPTER SCHOLARSHIP



The AGC Nebraska Chapter is pleased to offer an academic scholarship to a deserving student enrolled in the Heavy Equipment Operator Technician program at Central Community College in Hastings, Nebraska.

## Eligibility

Students who meet the following criteria are eligible for the scholarship:

- Planning to enroll or already enrolled in the Heavy Equipment Operator Technician program at CCC-Hastings
- U.S. citizen OR a documented permanent resident of the U.S.
- Minimum grade point average of 2.5 out of 4.0 or demonstrate achievement of competency

*The award is for the 2023-2024 school year.*

*The award is available to all students regardless of age, race, or gender.*

## Application Process

Application materials must be received by **September 6, 2024** in order to be considered.

The following materials should be submitted:

- Completed application form
- Two (2) letters of reference or recommendation from a teacher, coach, or other adult who is not an immediate relative
- Official high school transcript
- Short essay explaining why you deserve this scholarship

## Selection Process

Recipients will be selected based on application materials provided. Payment will be made to CCC-Hastings in accordance with the school's scholarship guidelines.

**Purpose of Scholarship**

To provide financial assistance to a student with an interest in pursuing a career in heavy equipment operation.

**Award**

\$4,000 scholarship payable to CCC-Hastings for tuition (\$2,000 per semester). Applications will be reviewed by the AGC Nebraska Chapter Scholarship Committee, which will consider applicant's interest in the construction field, grades, extracurricular activities, employment experience, and references.
