

AGC NEBRASKA CHAPTER

2-Year Technical Scholarship Criteria

A. ELIGIBILITY

1. Applicant must be:
 - a. a graduating high school student, or
 - b. enrolled, or plan to enroll, in a construction related program at a technical institute.
2. Applicant must be:
 - a. a U.S. citizen, or
 - b. documented permanent resident of the U.S.
3. Must have a desire to pursue a heavy-highway-utility construction career.
4. Minimum grade point average of 2.0 out of 4.0 or demonstrate achievement of competency.

B. INSTRUCTIONS

1. Applicant is responsible for ensuring that all of the following items are received by **DEADLINE DATE: August 15, 2024**
 - a. Completed and signed application
 - b. One letter of reference (not to exceed one page) from faculty advisor
 - c. One letter of reference from faculty, current or past employer, or unrelated adult
 - d. Official high school transcript
2. Incomplete application packages will NOT be considered.

C. AWARDS

1. A \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded to a student enrolled in a technical college with a construction related curriculum as agreed to by Scholarship Committee.
2. Applications will be reviewed by the AGC Nebraska Chapter Scholarship Committee, which will consider applicant's interest in the construction field, grades, extracurricular activities, employment experience, and references.
3. Selected applicants will be invited to join the Scholarship Committee for a lunch at the AGC Construction Industry Day in Lincoln in September 2024. After attending the event, the award may increase to \$2,000.

4. Grade transcripts and upcoming class schedule must be forwarded at the conclusion of each academic period. Recipient will not be reminded to provide this information; failure to do so will result in disqualification from the scholarship program.
5. Checks will be sent directly to designated institution on a quarterly or semester basis after recipients have returned their transcripts and upcoming class schedules.
6. Recipient is encouraged to seek summer employment with an AGC Nebraska Chapter member at some time during their technical enrollment.
7. Recipient is responsible for keeping the AGC Nebraska Chapter updated on address, phone number, and email changes.
