WHAT WILL IT COST?

At 2020–21 tuition and fee rates, completing a total of 37 credits, the **Heavy Equipment Operator Technician diploma** costs:

- Nebraska Resident - \$3,959
- Nonresident - \$5,661

At 2020–21 tuition and fee rates, completing a total of 61 credits, the **Heavy Equipment Operator Technician degree** costs:

- Nebraska Resident - \$6,527
- Nonresident - \$9,333

HOW LONG WILL IT TAKE?

The Heavy Equipment Operations diploma can be completed in two semesters by completing 18 credits the fall semester and 17 credits the spring semester, plus the Class B CDL training.
